

Appointments to Augustana Students' Council (ASC)

Purpose:

The purpose of this policy is to govern the process of appointing students onto the Augustana Students' Council for seats that remain open after the annual fall by-election.

Policy:

- In regard to Bylaw 6.04, wherever a seat remains vacant after the annual fall by-election, Augustana Students Council (ASC) will have the duty to appoint students to fill those seats.
- Nominations for appointment to the Augustana Students Council (ASC) would begin 72 hours after the by-election concludes.
- The ASA President shall put out a call to the student body asking for interested students to put forward their name for nomination onto the Augustana Students Council (ASC).
- Nominations shall stay open for 1 week (7 days). No nominations can take place after this window.
- Interested candidates shall be required to:
 - Be a part of the constituency they are applying to represent;
 - Attend an Augustana Students Council (ASC) meeting where they shall present their platform addressing their plans for students to council members and answer questions; and
 - If successful, appointees shall be required to attend ASA governance training.
- Augustana Students Council (ASC) must come to a decision, through vote, on whether or not the candidates will be appointed to the ASC within 24 hours.
- In the event that the Augustana Students Council (ASC) needs more time to deliberate on a decision, the candidates shall be informed on an appropriate timeline by the ASA President, not exceeding 1 week.
