

Faculty Liaison

Purpose: To engage members of the Augustana Faculty on issues related to the student experience on campus.

Policy:

- The Faculty Liaison will be an ex-officio, non-voting member of Students' Council. The Faculty Liaison does not hold representative power and will not have the authority to speak on the behalf of the ASA.
- The Faculty Liaison will be self-selected at Faculty Council. Once Faculty Council nominates a liaison, the nominated faculty member must be confirmed by a majority vote of Students' Council.
- Eligible faculty members:
 - must be academic staff at the University of Alberta Augustana Campus;
 - cannot be an active member on the Augustana Executive Council;
 - cannot represent the Augustana faculty on General Faculties Council the same year that they are the ASA's Faculty Advisor; and
 - cannot be a member of the AASUA Council or Executive Committee, or elected a member of any AASUA Standing Committee, Constituency Committee, Ad hoc Committee, or Joint Committee.
- The Faculty Liaison shall:
 - attend meetings of ASC when invited by the President, the Executive, or a majority vote of council; and
 - provide information and context, when requested, to Students' Council on issues pertaining to academics, faculty relations, and other issues within their expertise.
- Students' Council shall have the power to remove a liaison should Council deem the current liaison incapable of fulfilling their duties.
